A Resort Opens Outside Santa Fe

A new resort opened Thursday outside Santa Fe, N.M. Located on 57 acres at the foothills of the Sangre de Cristo Mountains, Encantado, an Auberge Resort, consists of a main lodge (with a restaurant, a lounge and meeting space), a 10,000-square-foot spa, a fitness center and pool and 65 luxury casitas. The casitas are outfitted with up-to-date technology as well as bathrooms with heated floors and soaking tubs, private terraces and fireplaces. Guests will have access to the 1.6-million-acre Santa Fe National Forest, and to downtown Santa Fe on a free shuttle service. Nightly rates

start at \$425. There is also a “bed and breakfast” promotion through next June. Those who book two or more nights will receive daily breakfast for two; those who stay three nights or more will receive the breakfast and a room upgrade (www.encantadoresort.com).
